#### **SPECIFICATIONS**

- Low-Pro Easy Mount application is designed for roof mounts only.
- Does not require monopoles, but still requires all other mounting practices as outlined in the SPIG for roof mounts using the 2" standard foot and mast.
- There is an 11 inch variance in height on the stubby mast versus the standard foot and mast.
- The Low-Pro Easy Mount utilizes a reinforced version of the DIRECTV standard foot.
- There are currently two different styles of approved Low-Pro Easy Mount (pictured far left).

### INSTALLATION CONSIDERATIONS

**PBI Version** 

- **Line Of Sight (LOS):** The Low-Pro Easy Mount is 11 inches shorter than the standard roof mount.
- Possible installation limitations in certain regions: The feed arm or LNB may contact the roof when mounted on a north facing roof pitch with an angle near 45 degrees in the following regions:
  - Midwest (i.e.: Minot ND), Pacific Northwest (i.e.: Bellingham WA), NewEngland (i.e.: Bangor ME)
- Winter weather limitations: Because the Low-Pro Easy Mount is shorter, regular snowfall may cause the LNB or reflector to be more easily covered by accumulating snow.
- **Roof pitch limitations:** The Low-Pro Easy Mount should not be used on a roof pitch greater than 45 degrees.
